VAT relief for disabled people

If you are disabled or have a long-term illness, you will not be charged VAT on products designed or adapted for your own personal or domestic use. Also, you will not be charged VAT on:

- the installation and any extra work needed as part of this
- repairs or maintenance
- spare parts or accessories

Qualification:

Your supplier can tell you, but usually products designed or adapted for a disability qualify. For example, certain types of:

- adjustable beds
- stair lifts
- wheelchairs
- medical appliances to help with severe injuries
- alarms
- motor vehicles - or the leasing of a motability vehicle
- building work like ramps, widening doors, installing a lift or toilet

To get the product VAT free your disability has to qualify. For VAT purposes, you're disabled or have a long-term illness if:

- you have a physical or mental impairment that affects your ability to carry out everyday activities, for example blindness
- you have a condition that's treated as chronic sickness, like diabetes
- you're terminally ill

You do not qualify if you're elderly but not disabled, or if you're temporarily disabled.

How to claim:

To claim the VAT exemption, you will be required to complete a form which the supplier of the equipment and the person making the claim will need to sign. This declaration form is available to download here:

Blue Badge Scheme / Disabled Parking

The Blue Badge Scheme is managed by Westmorland & Furness Council. It provides a national arrangement of parking concessions for people with severe walking difficulties, who travel either as drivers or passengers. The scheme also applies to registered blind people, people with hidden disabilities (such as dementia) and people with very severe upper limb disabilities, who regularly drive but cannot turn a steering wheel by hand. It allows badge holders to park in designated areas close to their destination.

How to apply:

Application is by completion of a form, online or on paper, and submission of the completed form with any accompanying documents, a passport-style photo and the appropriate fee.

National Key Scheme for Toilets for Disabled People (sometimes called Radar Keys)

The National Key Scheme (NKS) offers disabled people independent access to locked public toilets and includes over 1000 Changing Places toilets with added specialist equipment.

NKS was introduced because an increasing number of local authorities and other organisations felt the need to lock facilities to counter vandalism and misuse. Standardisation of the locks has been adopted by over 400 local authorities and there are over 10,000 accessible toilets for disabled people.

Purchasing a NKS key therefore allows access to NKS toilets throughout the country, although please note that the scheme is not in use everywhere. The genuine NKS keys are available to order via www.nks.co.uk website or direct from The Radar Key Company. Please note that RADAR itself no longer exists.

The price of the keys varies, depending on source and delivery charges but is between £5 - 10 in November 2025. Some local key cutters can also cut these keys – please check in your local area.

Personal Alarms

Various companies provide alarms which allow you to alert someone in an emergency, even when you are unable to reach the phone. They are operated by pressing a button on a pendant or bracelet, which alerts a monitoring service.

MedicAlert

MedicAlert is a UK registered charity providing a life-saving identification system for individuals with hidden medical conditions and allergies through a membership system.

How it works: In an emergency, vital information is available on the back of your MedicAlert Emblem, which is in the form of body-worn bracelets or necklets. Medical and emergency personnel can then telephone the given number and obtain further important details such as your name and address, doctor's details, current medication or next of kin.

This 24-hour, 365 days a year, emergency telephone service is managed from MedicAlert emergency call centre, with trained staff on hand to answer all calls. All calls are logged, with full details of the caller, the nature of the call and the response given.

As a registered charity, The MedicAlert Foundation can also provide free membership to individuals on a limited income.
