

Compass national site.

In August 2020, Compass will become a national system meaning that it will be available as a free to use resource for any organisation that is a charity, CIC or not-for-profit organisation anywhere in the UK.

Existing users will see some changes to the platform, but will still be able to log in using their original user name and password.

The main differences from the previous site include:-

A new national Home page, featuring a map with all registered organisations shown.

The ability to search for organisations by Area anywhere in the country.

Each organisation will now have their own Home Page that can be customised to reflect their organisation. This Home page is configurable by Organisational Administrators, through their own Organisational Administration page.

To log in to your own organisation, please use the log in button on the national Home page. Once logged in you can create a shortcut to your organisation so that you can go straight to your Home page to log on in the future.

If as an Organisation you have registered to use the secure modules of the site, you will find that the Case Management System (CRIS) is largely unchanged but you will now have the ability to make secure on-line referrals through the Multi-Agency Referral System (MARS) to any organisation nationally that is also MARS enabled.
